Built in 1882, originally as a grand country mansion, the hotel has a reputation for superb cuisine and fine wine and was awarded the prestigious *Cheshire Life, North Wales -Food & Wine Award* for 2004 and 2008.

It is now considered to be one of the finest Country House hotels in Wales awarded the *Visit Wales Gold Award* in 2010 and winners of the *Best Hotel, Anglesey Tourism Awards* two years running. Tre-Ysgawen Spa was one of only three finalists for the *Hotel Spa of the Year* at the *Professional Beauty Awards 2005 & 2009*.

The tranquil and beautifully maintained gardens of Tre-Ysgawen Hall provide the perfect backdrop for those memorable Wedding Day photographs.



Marriage, Civil Partnership & Reception

- The Capel Coch Room is perfect for the more intimate Ceremony or Reception. This room is beautifully decorated and can seat up to 30 guests for a Civil Ceremony or up to 18 for a Wedding Reception.
- The Britannia Room is the ideal setting for a Civil Ceremony from 30 to 75 guests seated. For Wedding Receptions, up to 34 guests can be seated Banqueting style at one large table.
- The Conservatory & Anglesey Suites are used for larger Wedding Receptions and Civil Ceremonies with the Conservatory having splendid views overlooking the gardens. Both the Conservatory and Anglesey Suites can seat up to 120 guests.
- The Pavilion was the first outdoor venue on Anglesey to be licensed for Civil Ceremonies. It is the ideal setting for couples looking for a luxurious and romantic venue in which to exchange their vows. It is licensed between April 1st and September 30th. Up to 120 seated guests can enjoy the ceremony on the lawn.



The hotel bar will be closed prior to Ceremonies, in line with legislation, although the Clock Tower Wine Bar will remain open.

The Receiving Line: A formal greeting of your guests upon arrival -
Bride's Mother, Groom's Father, Bride, Groom, Bride's Father, Groom's Mother.

Cutting the Wedding Cake: This follows an announcement by the Best Man.
The cake is first sliced by the Bride & Groom together before the dessert is served.

Toasts & Speeches: To follow the cutting of the cake, and they are in the following order

The Bridesmaids ~ Proposed by the Best Man

The Parents ~ Proposed by the Groom

- Pavilion supplement of £200.00

(We are required by law to have a licensed room suitable for your invited number of guests within the hotel should it not be possible to hold the ceremony in the Pavilion due to poor weather conditions. This decision lies with the Registrar)

Wedding Accommodation Tariff

The honeymoon suite, furnished with a four poster bed, is also equipped with a 6ft whirlpool bath and is offered complimentary to the Bride & Groom.*

(* A minimum of 50 guests required for the wedding breakfast)

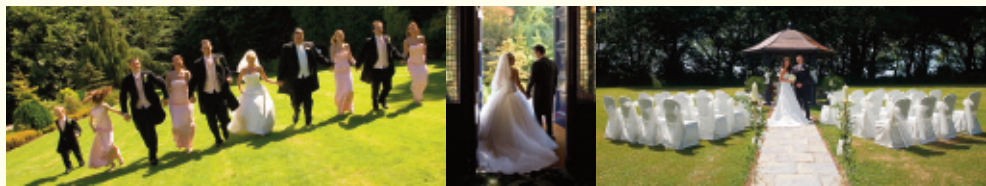
15 bedrooms depending on availability are reserved upon receipt of a deposit along with signed terms and conditions confirming your wedding. All bedrooms are en-suite and are equipped with tea and coffee making facilities, direct dial telephones, hairdryer, trouser press, widescreen digital television, teletext, radio and safe.

Single Room: £99.00 **Double Room:** £130.00 **Family Room:** £260.00

Cots are available complimentary and put up beds are charged at £25.00 per night.

- Prices are inclusive of full Welsh breakfast & VAT.
- Breakfast is available from 7.30a.m – 10.00a.m.
- Room service orders will incur a service charge and will be charged to individual rooms.
- Check in is from 2.00p.m with check out at 11.00a.m.
- Children under the age of 6 are not allowed in the Spa area.
- Children and teenagers from 6 to 16 years must be accompanied by an adult at all times and can only use the swimming pool between the hours of 9.00am and 11.00am, and 3.00p.m and 5.00p.m.
- Early check in is available; please refer to terms and conditions.
- Three months prior to your wedding you will be asked to provide your rooming allocation form.

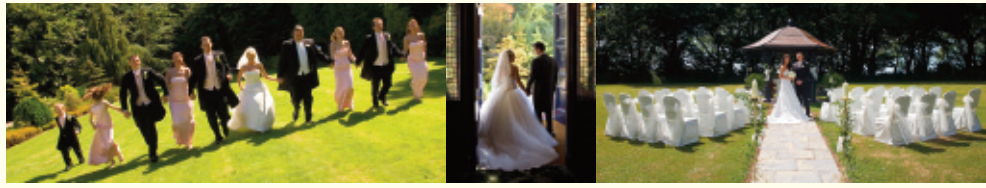

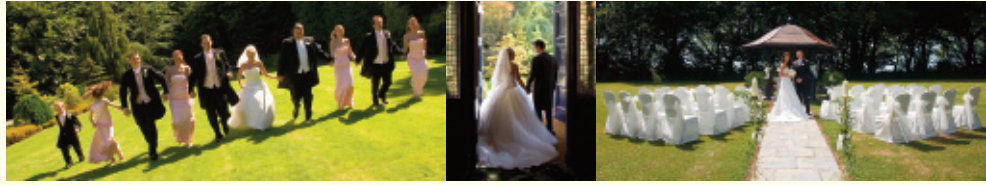

Notes

- We request that all weddings held on Saturdays during the peak months (May – September) be seated by 4.00p.m.
- You are responsible for booking the registrar for all the arrangements for the Ceremony. Please contact the registrar Mrs Marian Griffiths 01248 752564.
- All weddings with over 100 guests in the evening are subject to a £120.00 security fee.
- Exclusivity of the hotel is available for your wedding from £9000.00 per day. This includes use of the public rooms throughout the day, allocation of all 29 bedrooms on a bed and breakfast basis. The Clocktower and Spa remain open to the public.
- We do not offer the facility of corkage at the hotel for serving guests their own wine and champagne.

Wedding Bookings Terms and Conditions

1. RESERVATION

A provisional booking can be held for 14 days following which we reserve the right to release the date without prior consultation. In order to guarantee a reservation confirmation is required in writing along with a signed copy of these terms and conditions and a non-refundable, non-transferrable booking deposit of £1000.00. The letter of confirmation must fully state the organiser(s) and the person(s) fully responsible for the settlement of the final account to be settled no later than the morning of departure of the Bride & Groom.

2. MENUS

In order to maintain our high standards of cuisine we regret that a choice of Menu cannot be given for the Wedding Breakfast, therefore the Menu chosen will be served to all guests. Individual dietary requirements are catered for such as Vegetarian and Celiac but prior notice is required. Children are also an exception.

3. MINIMUM NUMBERS

We regret that during the months of May to September inclusive, a minimum number of 80 guests are required to attend the Wedding Breakfast. Should the number of attendees fall below this number; a room hire charge will be levied of £750.00 to account for the under-occupancy.

4. ACCOMODATION

Our rooms are of a very high standard and it takes time to keep them this way, therefore rooms are not available to check into until 2.00p.m. Should they be required earlier, we will require at least 14 days written notice and there will be a £50.00 surcharge per room (the earliest time they will then be ready is 12.30p.m)

Should any of your accommodated guests default on payment for their room you will be financially liable for any shortfall. Should any damages occur at Tre-Ysgawen Hall property or grounds as a result of willful act or default of you, any service contractors you have arranged or your guests you will be liable for the cleaning, repair or replacement as appropriate of damaged items including compensation for loss of business while such damage is being repaired.

All wedding guests should note that the hotel bar closes at 12.30a.m. For residents the bar will re-open after non-resident guests have departed (This will be the decision of the duty manager).

5. MINIMUM CHARGES

Confirmation is required in writing of the final catering numbers at least ten working days prior to the date of the wedding. This number will be the minimum charged for. However, should this not be received, Tre-Ysgawen Hall reserves the right to charge in full for the catering numbers as confirmed on the booking. If this number increases charges will of course be amended accordingly.

6. DEPOSITS & PREPAYMENTS

- In order to guarantee a reservation, confirmation is required in writing along with a signed copy of these terms and conditions and a non-refundable, non-transferrable booking deposit of £1000.00
- Six months prior to the wedding, a further £1,500 prepayment is required. This is non-refundable and non transferrable. Please refer to Section 7- Cancellation Policy.
- 90% of the total estimated cost will be required two weeks prior to your wedding.

7. CANCELLATION POLICY

In the unfortunate circumstances of you having to cancel or postpone your confirmed booking at any time prior to the event you will be liable to Tre-Ysgawen Hall for the below costs: -

Period of notice for Cancellation/Postponement: -

12 to 18 months – 25% of expected costs

6 to 12 months – 50% of expected costs

6 months or less – 100% of expected costs

Should you wish to make any significant changes to your event or the expected number of guests Tre-Ysgawen Hall reserves the right to amend the rates and all facilities offered.

8. GENERAL

The tariffs quoted are correct at the time of going to print but may be subject to alteration without prior notice. For any weddings held in 2010 onwards we reserve the right to pass on any cost increases or amend our terms and conditions as necessary and will notify you in writing of any such changes. We also reserve the right to change the prices of any of the hotel rooms at any point following their refurbishment, and again you will be notified of such works in writing.

9. Tre-Ysgawen Hall shall be under no liability if they are unable to carry out provision of the contract for any reason beyond their control including (without limiting the foregoing) Act of God, legislation, war, fire, flood, drought, failure of power supply, lock out, strike, or other action taken by employees in contemplation of furtherance of a dispute or owing to any inability to procure materials required for the performance of the contract. In these circumstances, every effort will be made to accommodate the booking in another hotel of similar standard.

10. Whilst Tre-Ysgawen Hall has taken all reasonable steps to ensure that the information contained in its brochure, tariffs leaflets and advertisements are accurate, it reserves the right to alter, substitute or withdraw any service, facility or amenity without notice if necessary at the time.

11. HOTEL POLICY

All prices include Value Added Tax at the current rate. The Hotel reserves the right to amend charges from time to time without prior consultation. Any damages incurred during your wedding will be charged directly to your wedding account. You will be responsible for the actions of all of your guests. Hotel Accommodation may vary from the specific allocation list provided where unforeseen circumstances occur. Tre-Ysgawen Hall reserves the right to alter wedding party room allocations in such an event, without prior consultation. Please ensure you have read the Spa Rules document, as it will be your responsibility to inform your resident wedding party guests of these rules, paying particular attention to the paragraph concerning the use of the Spa facilities by children. We reserve the right if any damage or under charge is made that payment will be taken at a later date. You will be charged and notified in writing of this.
